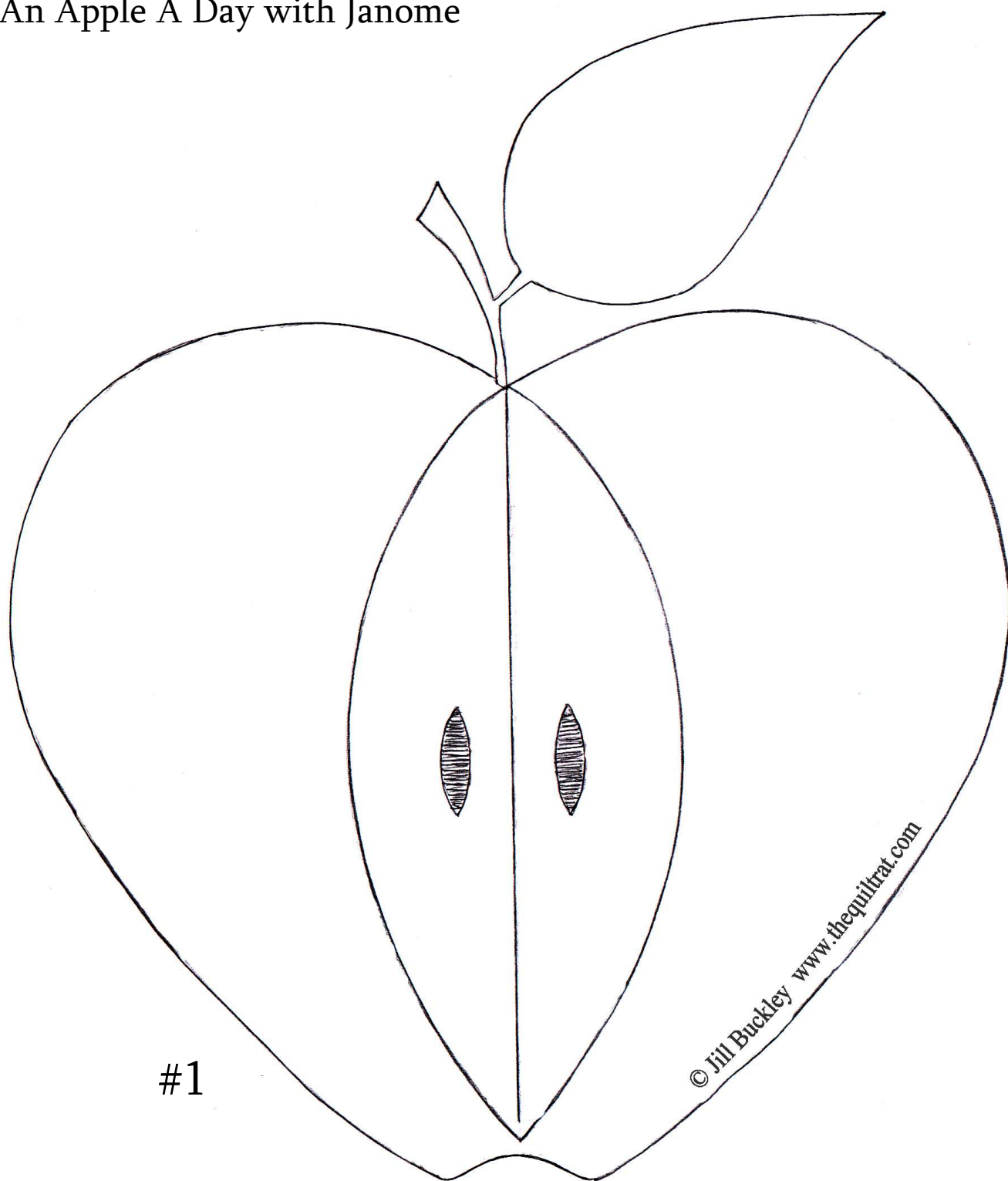
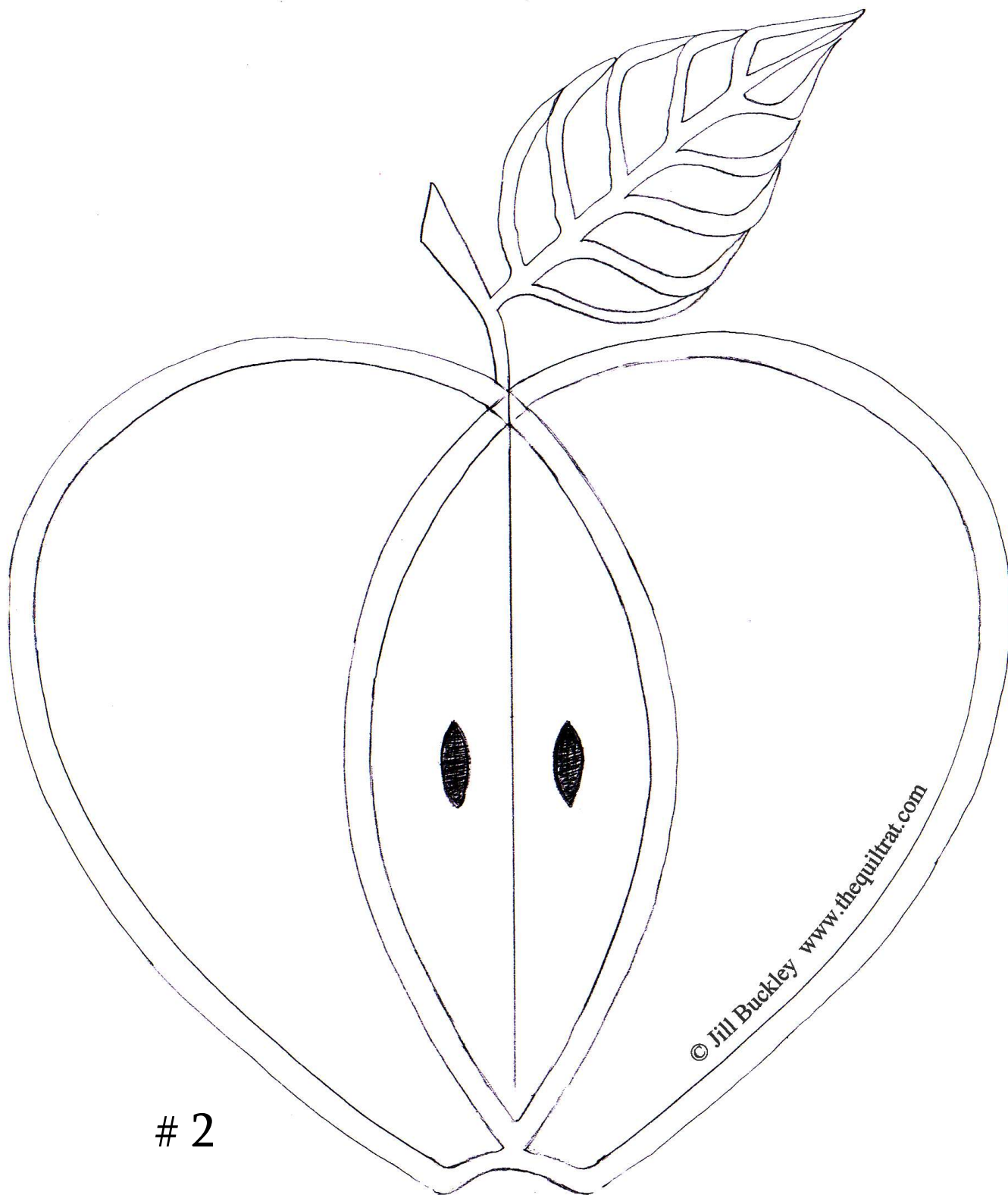


## An Apple A Day with Janome

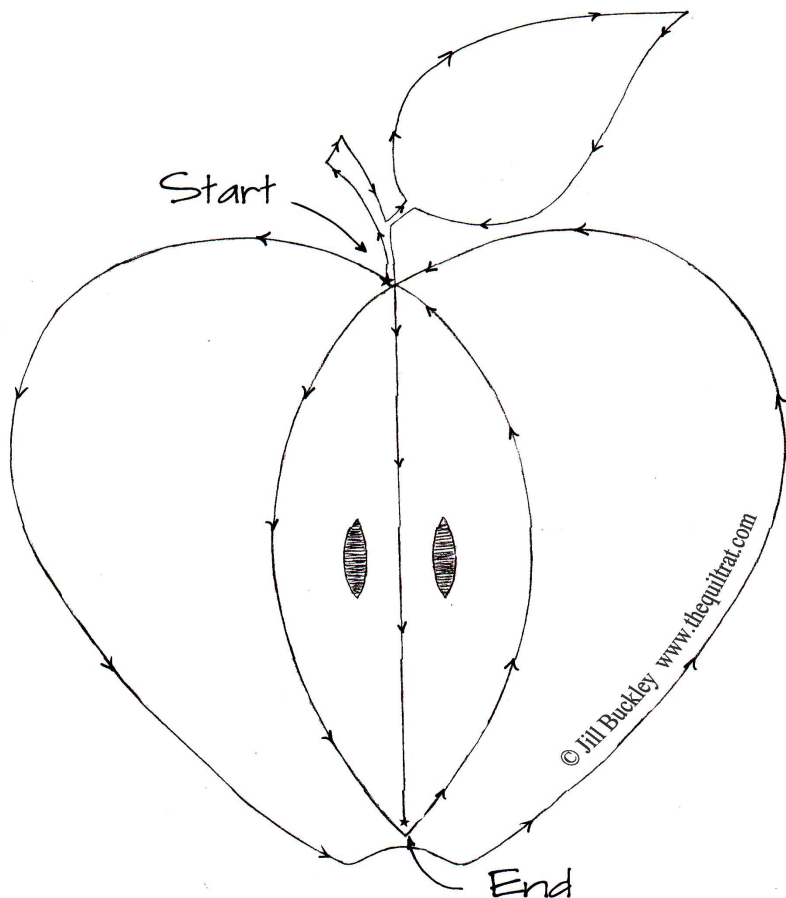


Designs for free motion quilting. 3 apple designs to choose from.

#1 is fairly basic, #2 requires a bit more skill,  
while #3 is an example showing how to take the design a little further.  
Stitch as simple or complex as you like. Enjoy!

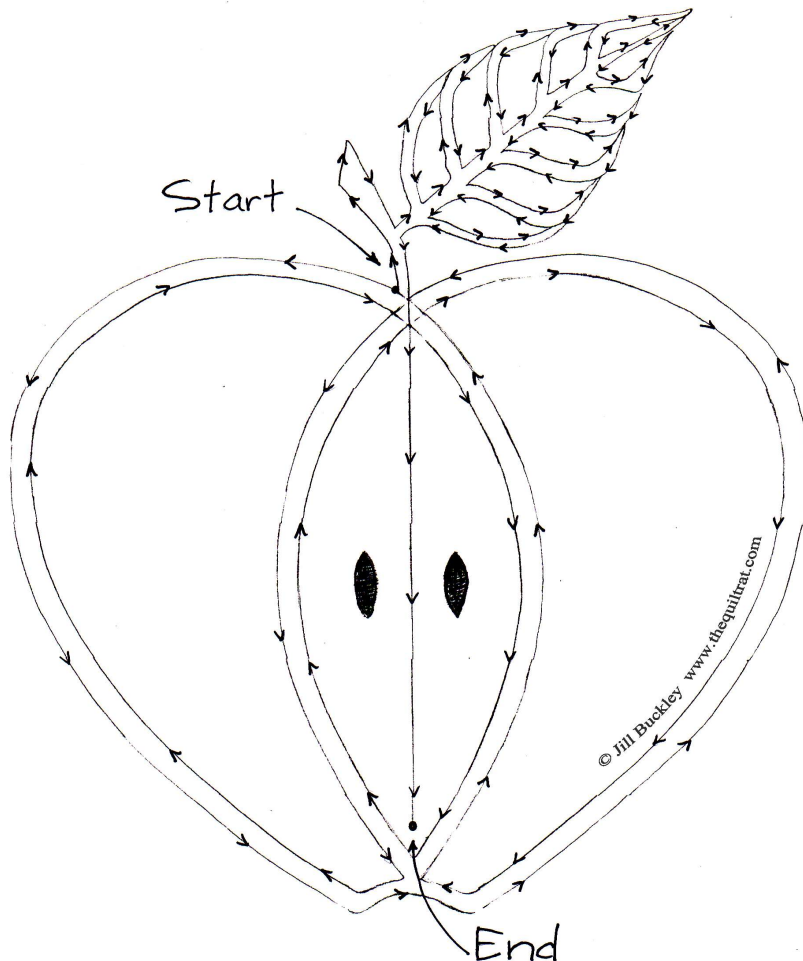
The diagrams on this page illustrate the beginning and end for each design.

By following the arrows, you can stitch the entire design with one fluid line.

Bring the thread up at the “start” point, begin the stitch path following the arrows in a counterclockwise direction

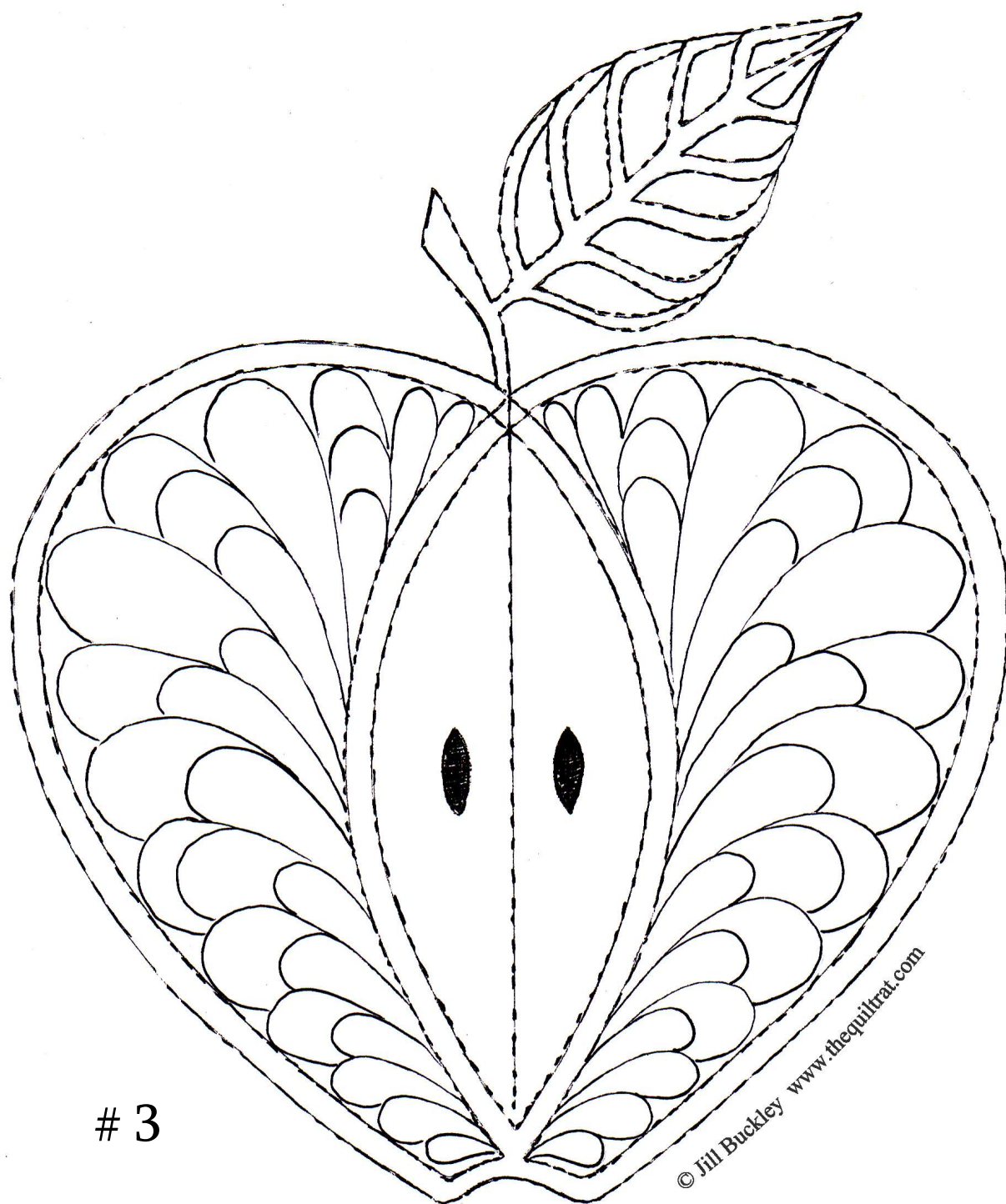
The “seeds” were done using stitch # 27 (elongated) in Mode 3, a built in decorative stitch on the Janome MC6600p.

Use a similar stitch on your machine, hand embroider or even use beads.



The designs on pages 1, 2 & 4 are actual size, ready to be printed, traced and stitched

You may also reduce or enlarge them as required for your specific project.



Instead of feathers, choose to add circles, swirls,  
or any other type of free motion quilting stitch you'd most prefer
